In addition, Arlene always found time to be involved in leadership roles with a number of community and church organizations. After Arlene and Philip moved Prescott in 1989, she worked for the Prescott National Forest until her retirement in 1997.

Arlene enjoyed traveling to explore different cultures and meet new people. Her love of life and zest for living were evident in her collection of new friends whenever she went. Arlene was diagnosed with breast cancer in February 2003 and had undergone extensive chemotherapy since that time. Her death came December 7, 2004 at home under the care of YRMC Hospice Program.
